RECORDING VIDEO ON THE CANVAS STUDENT APP

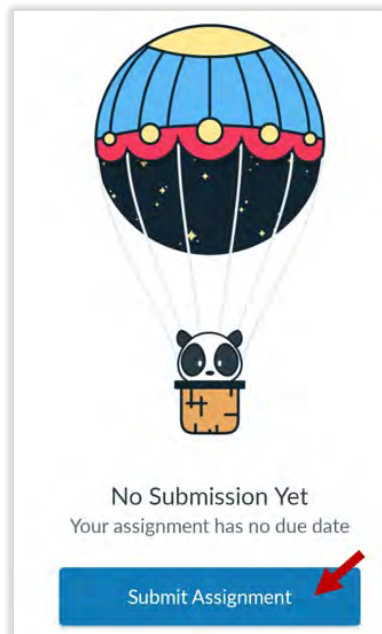
If your instructor asks you to submit a video recording as a Discussion response or complete an assignment, you can record directly using the Canvas Student App. This is especially important since iPhones save video as .mov files, which can easily become too large to upload to Canvas.

Recording Your Video

Open the Canvas Student App, and navigate to the Assignment or Discussion where you need to submit work.

For an Assignment

Open the Assignment and tap the **Submit Assignment** button.

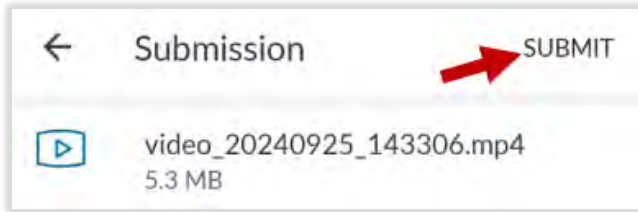


Tap to select **Media Recording** then **Record Video**.



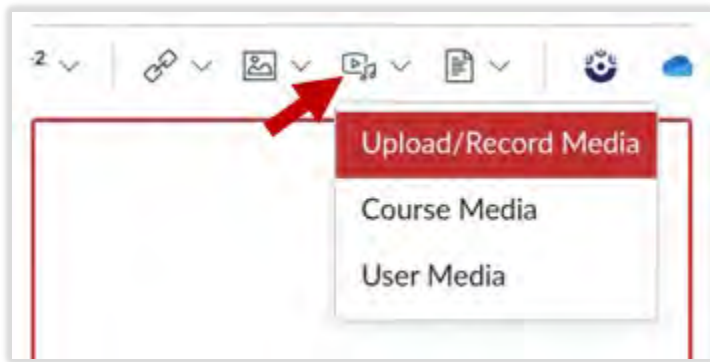
If asked, allow the Canvas Student App to access your phone. Record your video and click **OK**.

Tap **Submit** and be patient; the upload may take a few minutes. When the upload is complete, you should receive a “confetti toss” and a notification that you’ve **Successfully Submitted!**

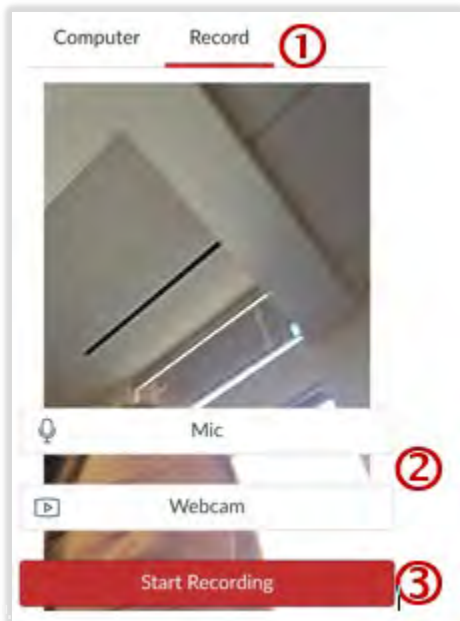


For a Discussion

Open the Discussion, and tap **Reply**. Above the text editing box, tap the icon to add a media recording. You may need to scroll to the right to find the icon. Select **Upload/Record Media**.

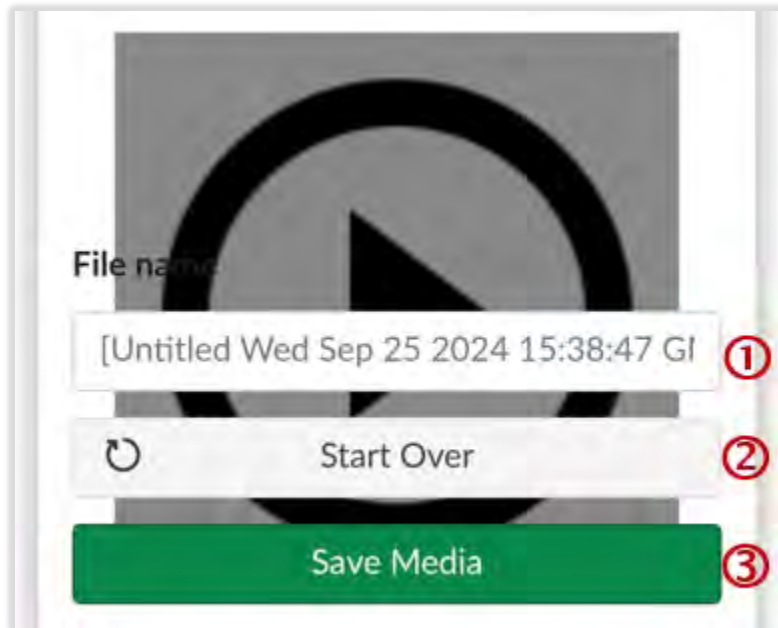


1. Open the **Record** tab.
2. Use the **Mic** and **Webcam** button to select which camera and microphone you want to use.
3. Tap **Start Recording** and record your video.



When done, tap **Finish Recording**.

1. You can rename your file to something that makes sense to you.
2. You can **Start Over** if you don't like the recording.
3. If you're ready to post, tap **Save Media**.



When returned to the text editing box, click **Reply**.
